Message Talking Points

"It's Time to ASK" by Pastor David Dirmann March 13, 2016

James 4:2 NLT (Review together)

- Emphasizing the last part—we don't have because we don't ask.
- God loves to bless His children and pour out His goodness.

DISCUSSION:

- Can you think of a time when you desired something but you didn't ask God for it?
 Now can you think of a time when you asked God for something you desired, and He responded by blessing you?
- Which felt better? ©

THREE QUESTIONS

Question 1: WHO are we asking?

- Answer: The Father (John 16:23–24; Matt. 6:9–11)
- God wants us to ask so we don't ever feel like it was just a coincidence when it comes to pass.

Question 2: WHAT are we asking for?

- Answer: What we desire (John 15:7)
- You actually give God pleasure when you ask and receive from Him. (Luke 12:32)

Question 3: **HOW** are we asking?

- Answer: We need to pray according to His will—His word (1 John 5:14–15)
- If you knew that *every* prayer you prayed was being listened to by God, you would pray more.

Romans 10:17 (Review together)

DISCUSSION:

- The harvest of His words abiding in you (John 15:7) is faith in your heart.
- Even things you've asked before, come back and ask again.
